Village member Dolores
Blegen grew up in Arkansas
and Illinois, where she
attended high school. She
worked her way (with the aid
of a scholarship) through
Northwestern University,
earning a bachelor's degree in
Political Science. After
college, she worked in social

services in Chicago and as a Vista volunteer doing community organizing in Kansas City, Missouri.

Among Dolores's most memorable experiences are the two years (1967–1969) she spent in Viet Nam, teaching English to young teens under the auspices of a nongovernmental organization. In 2019, to celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of her stay there, she returned to the same town for a very moving reunion with her former students and other friends, and she hopes to arrange another visit to see them soon.

Back from Viet Nam, Dolores worked for the DC Department of Social Services for around twenty years. She met her husband Roger (a Village member until his death in 2017), and they moved to Cheverly in 1978. She and Roger joined the US Army reserves, where she obtained the rank of captain. They also attended graduate school, where she earned her master's



degree. She ultimately retired from full-time work so that she could be home with their children, Patina (who is also a Village member), Candice, and Christopher, who are now grown. More recently, she celebrated her eightieth birthday by taking a parachute jump from a helicopter!
