Drive-Thru Flu Shot Clinic

Saturday, October 15, 9:00am – 3:00pm
at Cheverly Community Center.

Cheverly Village, partnering with Wegmans Pharmacy, invites you to a drive- thru, bike-thru, and walkup clinic to get your flu shot. Flu shots for children, ad-ults and seniors will be available. Pneumonia and Shingrix shots will also be available as well as the DTAP vaccine.

We can confirm that the Pfizer Covalent Booster will also be available, and that the flu shot and the bivalent booster can safely be administered in the same visit!

Registration for vaccine clinic *MUST* be done in advance, and you will find additional required forms for the clinic on www.CheverlyVillage.org, under “Events List.” Printed versions will be available at the clinic also.

Medicare and *most* insurance will cover vaccinations through the clinic. No one will be turned away from a flu vaccine for lack of insurance or inability to pay, and all insurance companies are covering covid bivalent boosters.

This group will evolve as speakers from various disciplines are invited to stimulate conversation on such things as:

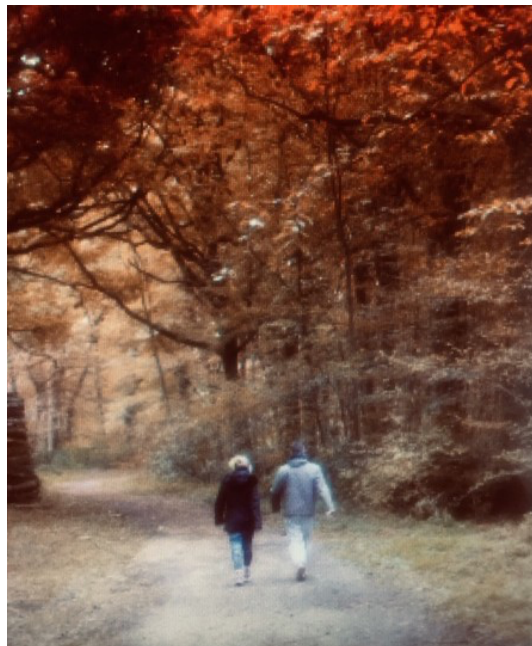
- Who should have Power of

Of course, all conversations fare better with tea and cookies or wine and cheese; the group will decide! Stay tuned for details!

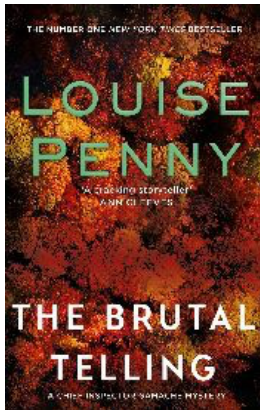
October Walk-a-Mile Challenge

Wednesday, **October 12**, 2:00 – 4:00 PM.

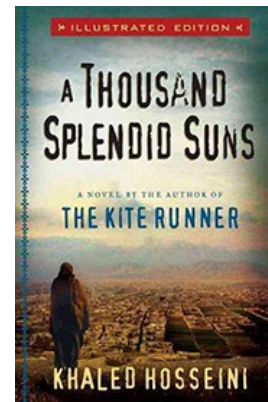
We will discuss *The Brutal Telling* by Louise Penny, a Canadian author well known for her sophisticated literary mysteries.

Wednesday, **November 9**, 2:00 – 4:00 PM.

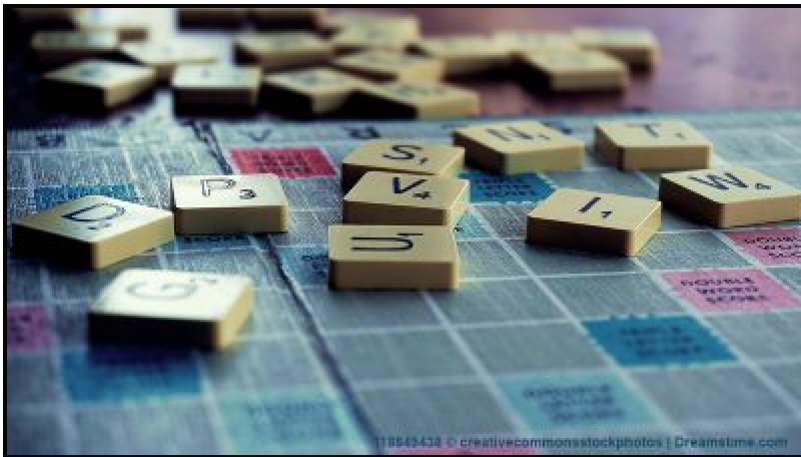
A Thousand Splendid Suns by Khaled Hosseini tells a family story set against the volatile events of Afghanistan from Soviet invasion through Taliban control.
