Saturday, May 4, 2024, 2:00 to 4:00 PM: Peace of Mynd will meet in Narthex of Cheverly United Methodist Church.


Peace of Mynd Session # 4 will discuss the non-medical ways one may find comfort of


body, mind, and soul.




### **Cheverly Village Book Club**




